Mud Pit Rules

- OPEN 8:00am sunset Hours are subject to change without warning or notification
- THIS IS A FAMILY FRIENDLY AREA - rule, lude or foul language or behavior will not be tolerated
- **NO** side wall exiting of pit
- Straight line runs through Pit only
- **NO** more than two (2) vehicles in pit at the same time
- NO cookies (throwing of debris) at pit entrances
- Hose at pit provided for quick rinse only for those using the pit

Day Use Rules

- Day Use Area open from daylight to dark.
- **NO** overnight camping.
- Keep garbage in garbage cans.
- **NO** discharge of firearms in the park.
- Speed limit in Day Use Area 10 MPH.
- Current ATV operating permit or Out of state ATV permit recognized by state of Oregon required on all Off Highway Vehicles.

Trail Rules

- NO Motor Vehicles off marked roads or trails.
- Current ATV Permit sticker or Out of State ATV permit sticker recognized by state of Oregon required on all Off Highway Vehicles.
- Spark arrester required. Must be USFS approved.
- Silencer required (Max. 99 db).
- **NO** trespassing on private property.
- NO OHV use on USFS Road 21.
- Safety Education card on all ATV All riders under 18 must wear a helmet. No throwing trash on the trails.

Park Rules

- **NO** discharge of firearms in the park.
- NO motor vehicles off marked roads or trails.
- Reduce noise from 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
- Speed limit in campground areas 10 MPH
- Safety Education card shall be carried (on person) by all OHV users.
- Keep fires in designated fire rings or grills ONLY
- Keep dogs shall be under owners immediate Control, owners responsible for dogs actions
- ATV operating permit stickers required on all Off Highway Vehicles (OHV)
- Quiet time (reduce noise) 10:00p.m. 6:00a.m.
